Still Life

- “Traditional or creative non-abstract grouping of **functional, realistic objects and plant material with a theme.**”
- “**Objects are more dominant** to the theme than plant material.”
- “Plant material may or may not represent a floral design.”

Still Life

- **“Objects are dominant in the design and must be true to normal size and function.”**
- “A small ceramic duck, for example, would be unacceptable; however, a duck decoy because it is life-size, might be included...”
- “Plant material may be attached to...the staging or placed in related groupings on the table.

Still Life

- “Categorized as Creative Design because it doesn’t conform to characteristics and restrictions of a Traditional Design.”
- “Some plant material is essential... (but) may be cut or container grown, fresh or dried

Still Life

- All components must be related to the theme and be life-sized.
- The theme must be obvious.
- Realism is important, no abstraction
